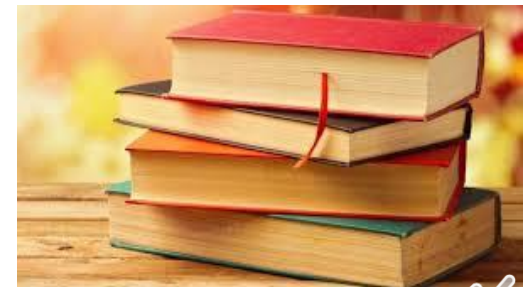
- Predominately online programs with a few mandatory onsite days. (6-8 weeks advanced notice of dates)
- New York State tuition as NYS Residents

- Seats for all required classes are guaranteed. (You cannot be closed out of a required course.)



- Applications open August 1st
- Please check the School of Nursing website for application deadline dates
- Online electronic application is available through our website at:

- Unofficial transcripts from all colleges/universities ever attended must be uploaded onto the electronic application (must be readable transcripts)
- \$100 application fee
- Current curriculum vitae/resume
- All preadmission coursework (Undergraduate Health Assessment and Undergraduate Statistics) must be completed with a grade of C or higher.
- Current and maintained RN License
- References – submitted electronically via the online application
 - Email addresses of 3 professional references
 - Vary your selection
 - Family and friends are not acceptable
- Personal statement is required
- Completion of all preadmission coursework is required prior to starting the program.
- Virtual interview and testing



- Bachelor of Science degree with a major in nursing (For applicants with non-nursing bachelor degrees, see the Clinical Practice Portfolio requirement on upcoming slide)*
- A minimum of **one year's** recent relevant experience (preferred)
- Unofficial transcripts from all college/universities attended
- Cumulative grade point average of at least 3.0
- Current professional Registered Nurse license
- Three online letters of recommendation
- Personal Statement
- Meet all Technical Standards for Admission and Retention

- Personal Statement
- Meet all Technical Standards for Admission and Retention

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* Clinical Practice Portfolio - Registered Nurse applicants to a **master's** program with a non-nursing bachelor's degree are required to submit a clinical practice portfolio to be evaluated for baccalaureate-level nursing competencies upon conditional admission once they have been admitted to a program. A non-refundable fee of \$300 is required for the portfolio evaluation. Upon successful completion and approval from the Program Director and the Chair of the Department of Advanced Practice Nursing Programs of the portfolio, the student will be matriculated to the program. If the portfolio does not meet academic standards, the student cannot progress in the program.



All APRN Programs have one admission semester:

Summer Semester- begins at the end of May

Mandatory Onsite orientation is usually scheduled for mid-April.

Accepted students will receive 6-8 weeks notification of the orientation date.

ORIENTATION IS MANDATORY





Additional Requirements Upon Admission

- NP Student Malpractice Insurance Required
- Official transcripts from all colleges/universities attended
- Transcripts from foreign institutions must be evaluated for transfer equivalency credits by an NACES accredited evaluation service, such as the World Education Services (WES) <http://www.wes.org>
- All newly admitted students will receive an email from the SON Required Documentation email address, shown below, with detailed instruction to utilize the required CastleBranch web-based software system. This system requires a one time fee and is where students will upload and manage required documents."son_required_documentation@stonybrook.edu"



Master's Part-time Pathway

- Three-year pathway
- Students complete 2 - 7 credits per semester or session
- Continuous pathway

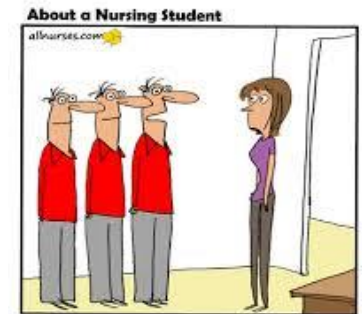


Advanced Certificate Part-time Pathway

- Course pathway determined upon completion of a Gap Analysis by the Program Director
- Two-year pathway
- Students complete 2 - 7 credits per semester or session
- Continuous pathway



- All students are accepted on the part-time pathway
- The part-time pathway was developed for working RNs and NPs
- Designed so that working students can do well and progress into competitive NP positions and/or into further graduate degree programs.

Process for Clinical Experiences

- The Office of Clinical Placements facilitates the processing of clinical placement **requests and contracts for all clinical affiliations within the master's and advanced** certificate programs.
- Students are required to network to locate their own clinical placements and preceptors. The Office of Clinical Placements works collaboratively with faculty to secure clinical placement sites for students.
- Once a suitable site is identified, students submit a clinical placement request form for processing.
- The clinical hours associated with four clinical courses vary from 600-720 hours total depending on the program.
