

Basic EKG Course:

This Continuing Education Course offering is designed for Nurses or Nursing Students who are interested in learning how to interpret EKG rhythms, their etiology and treatment. This course content will include review of cardiac anatomy and electrophysiology as well as rhythm identification and will prepare nurses to care for patients on telemetry monitoring. Students will have the opportunity to practice rhythm identification and course review. State of the art simulation will be utilized. Students must purchase required text and calipers. **Students will be expected to complete a final exam to obtain CE Credit and Certificate. 30 contact hours**

Phlebotomy:

This Continuing Education Course offering is designed for Nurses or Nursing Students who are interested in developing skills in blood drawing techniques. This course content will include review of venous and arterial systems. Students will learn proper procedures and equipment used in blood collection including blood collection from Central Venous Access Devices. Students will also learn about complications and appropriate interventions. Students will have the opportunity to utilize state of the art simulation equipment for this learning experience. **3.5 contact hours.**

IV Therapy and Infusion:

This Continuing Education Course offering is designed for Nurses or Nursing Students who are interested in developing skills in IV placement and infusion. This course will include a review of venous and arterial systems. Students will learn the proper procedures and equipment used for IV placement and infusion therapy. A review of assessment for adverse responses and events will also be covered. Students will also have the opportunity to utilize state of the art simulation equipment for this learning experience. **3.5 contact hours**

Basic Health Assessment:

This Continuing Education Course offering is an intense Three-Day Course. It is designed for Nurses or Nursing Students who are interested in enhancing their skills or for the new Nurse who has not yet joined the workforce. This is an excellent course to help you expand and maintain your assessment skills. This course will encompass a head to toe assessment including major body systems along with identification of the most common abnormal findings. You will also learn in depth interviewing skills and application of the nursing process in order to accurately document findings.
